

Innamincka Office Complex & Turbine Hall

Innamincka is a tiny settlement in north-east South Australia. It is situated on the banks of Coopers Creek in the state's Channel Country, and surrounded by the Strzelecki, Tirari and Sturt's Stony Deserts.

This project incorporated the design and construction of the office building, and turbine hall including management of the sourcing and provision of materials, installation and construction of buildings, Works included the supply and installation of a sewerage treatment plant as well as the installation of furniture and equipment, and testing and commissioning of facilities, utilities and services.

Decmil prefabricated components of works off site and coordinated the manufacture of joinery, windows and other building components out of Toowoomba Queensland.

This project was very remote and isolated, with only one delivery in and out per week.

Geodynamics Limited was formed solely to focus on developing renewable geothermal energy generation from hot fractured rocks (HFR) in Australia.
