



Pluto LNG Project

Works Summary



Decmil was awarded its first \$20million contract from Woodside in 1988 and in 2008 was engaged to commence works on Woodside's Pluto LNG Project – one of Australia's biggest LNG projects. Decmil has been awarded a number of separate contracts including;

Pluto Site A – Civil works

Decmil was contracted to complete all civil works associated with the import and export pipelines (jetty and ship berthing facility excluded) for the storage and loading facility of Woodside's Pluto LNG Project.

Temporary Facilities & Miscellaneous Civil works

Decmil Australia was awarded a Design and Construct contract for all temporary construction site facilities, related infrastructure and utilities and miscellaneous civil works.

Pluto Civil Finishing Works

Decmil was awarded Onshore Civil Finishing works on Site A and B including Burrup Road access works, DPA security upgrade works and broader civils scope of works.

Pluto Central Control Room Building

Decmil Australia was awarded the contract for two buildings at Woodside's Pluto LNG Project, one to house the state of the art Central Control Room and administration centre (CCR) and the other a Guardhouse/Medical facility.
